Graduate Core Seminar: History, Theory and Practice

This is the second half of a year-long course that provides an introduction to graduate study in history in general, and Stony Brook's Graduate Program in History in particular. At the end of the Fall term, students wrote an extended proposal for a Core project – a substantial history paper using primary sources that makes an original contribution and intervention into scholarship on the chosen topic. Spring term is primarily dedicated to research, writing, revising, and completion of this Core paper. Required course readings will be minimal, and class meetings will be used to discuss research and writing, and workshop stages of paper development, as well as to present their research to the class. This course is for History MA (academic track) and PhD students who already completed the first half of Core.
